## SUSTAINABILITY MEASURES

Limited use of pesticides; **practices eco-sustainable farming**, including planting of cover crops, sustainable pest control, and use of natural fertilizers.

Created PICA (Integrated Agricultural and Viticultural Cartographic Platform), a revolutionary vineyard mapping program that ensures the best crop management and yields and **consistently steers member winegrowers towards total sustainability.**

All Cavit labels and cases are printed using **eco-friendly water-based ink.**

99% of cardboard used is recycled; glass used to produce Cavit wine bottles is 80% recycled.

**3,200 solar panels** on the roof of the warehouse and winery generate around 800 MWh (megawatt hours) per year.

### COMMUNITY OUTREACH

**La Marne Food Bank:** Seven tons of food collected & donated since 2009.

### SUSTAINABILITY MEASURES

Since 2004, the winery has **recycled 18 metric tons of cork from production & tastings.**

## COMMUNITY OUTREACH

**50+ year partnership with the University of Florence.** Students are invited to come to the estate to experiment with site selection, clonal and selection massale research, vineyard management, and cover crop testing.

Since the 1970s, the Poggio al Vento vineyard has acted as a research laboratory for Sangiovese clonal selection and experimentation. **Top-performing clones are shared with producers across Montalcino.**

## SUSTAINABILITY MEASURES

**Largest certified organic farm in Tuscany**

Since 2010, the whole estate (including vineyards, olive groves, gardens, etc.) is farmed organically.

1,000 acres have been **farmed biodynamically** since 2018.

Col d'Orcia's partnership with the University of Florence aims to **develop better cover crop material and erosion control, preventing water pollution, soil loss, and wildlife habitat destruction.**

Estate uses fermented compost from recycled organic waste to reduce greenhouse gases and revitalize the soil.

There is an ongoing **carbon footprint reduction** project to lower the estate's output, including greenhouse gas emissions.

**Solar panels** are installed on the winery roof.

## COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Fontanafredda has an **incredible network of partner farmers**, providing the winery with excellent quality grapes to complement their estate fruit, generation after generation. Fontanafredda works with these partners to transition towards cleaner agriculture and organic farming.

Created the Centro Ricreativo Aziendale Lavoratori, a **social club for enriching employee life** through group activities, and hosts an annual educational summer camp for children of employees.

## SUSTAINABILITY MEASURES

**Largest certified organic winery** in the Piedmont region.

All the power in Fontanafredda's village is generated from **solar panels installed on the cellar buildings**, and the forklifts and tractors are electric or biomethane powered.

Glass bottles are a **minimum of 80% recycled glass**, labels are printed on **FSC (Forest Stewardship Council®) certified recycled paper**, and all wines use Nomacorc, a **plant-based cork that is recyclable** and produced with a zero-carbon footprint.

Outer packaging is made of **75% recycled fibers** and comes from Smurfit Kappa, Europe's leading corrugated packaging company which is committed to sustainable forest management.

## Icons of Fine Sicilian Wine

**“Planeta Terra”** is the label the winery places on its eco-stewardship practices.

### COMMUNITY OUTREACH

In collaboration with the Mediterranean Biodiversity Foundation, Planeta is carrying out a project to **reintroduce the Francolino bird** to Sicily.

### SUSTAINABILITY MEASURES

Planeta’s Menfi wineries have **300 square meters of photovoltaic panels**, which provide a large portion of their power.

All wines use the **100% Sicily bottle**, which is produced with recycled glass from waste collected on the island.

The **wineries are built to protect the landscape** — Capo Milazzo, in particular, is completely “disassemblable” and can be removed without harming the environment.

Undergoing Viti Diverse, a project aimed at protecting and enhancing **the genetic diversity of grape varieties** and ensuring the sustainability of Sicilian vineyards.

Planeta **recycles tons of plastic and paper** each year, and most materials are printed on certified recycled paper.

# Making the Ordinary Extraordinary in Drumshanbo, Ireland

## CERTIFICATIONS

## COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Has **created over 100 jobs** in the Drumshanbo community — including hiring 15 Ukrainian refugees.

**Supporter of Tidy Towns**, an annual competition organized by Ireland's Department of Rural and Community Development.

**Creating a community center** by renovating the former local Methodist Church, which was on the verge of dereliction.

Member of Repak, **a non-profit organization that helps Irish businesses recycle their packaging**. Member fees fund household recycling bins, bottle banks, civic amenities, and business back-door packaging recycling in communities across Ireland.

## SUSTAINABILITY MEASURES

Distillery runs on **100% green-sourced (solar and wind) electricity**.

In 2023, The Shed established an **80-acre nature reserve**, along with 100 acres of commonage for livestock, which is shared with two dozen local farmers.

In the nature reserve, the team has planted 150 native Irish hedgerows and wildflowers, is restoring the old stone cottages on the land, and has **created a bee haven** with six hives.

Uses **locally and nationally sourced ingredients** wherever possible — nettles and meadowsweet are foraged from Drumshanbo fields, while barley and oats come from the Midlands and Southeast of Ireland.

Gift shop and restaurant feature **locally sourced organic vegetables and honey**, and all coffee is fair trade.

## SUSTAINABILITY MEASURES

Yealands is committed to becoming **carbon**

**wind turbines, and vine prunings** (10% burned  
for heat) account for 25% of annual energy  
requirements.

**Bottles are 89% lighter** than standard glass  
wine bottles to reduce carbon footprint, and all  
packaging is recyclable.

Biodiversity plan **restores over 250 hectares**  
of coastal, wetland, and natural areas.

**Wildflowers and cover crops** between vines  
encourage biodiversity, improve soil structure,  
provide natural drainage, and increase soil  
carbon.

Sheep keep vine rows tidy, **reducing passes**  
**made by tractors.**
